



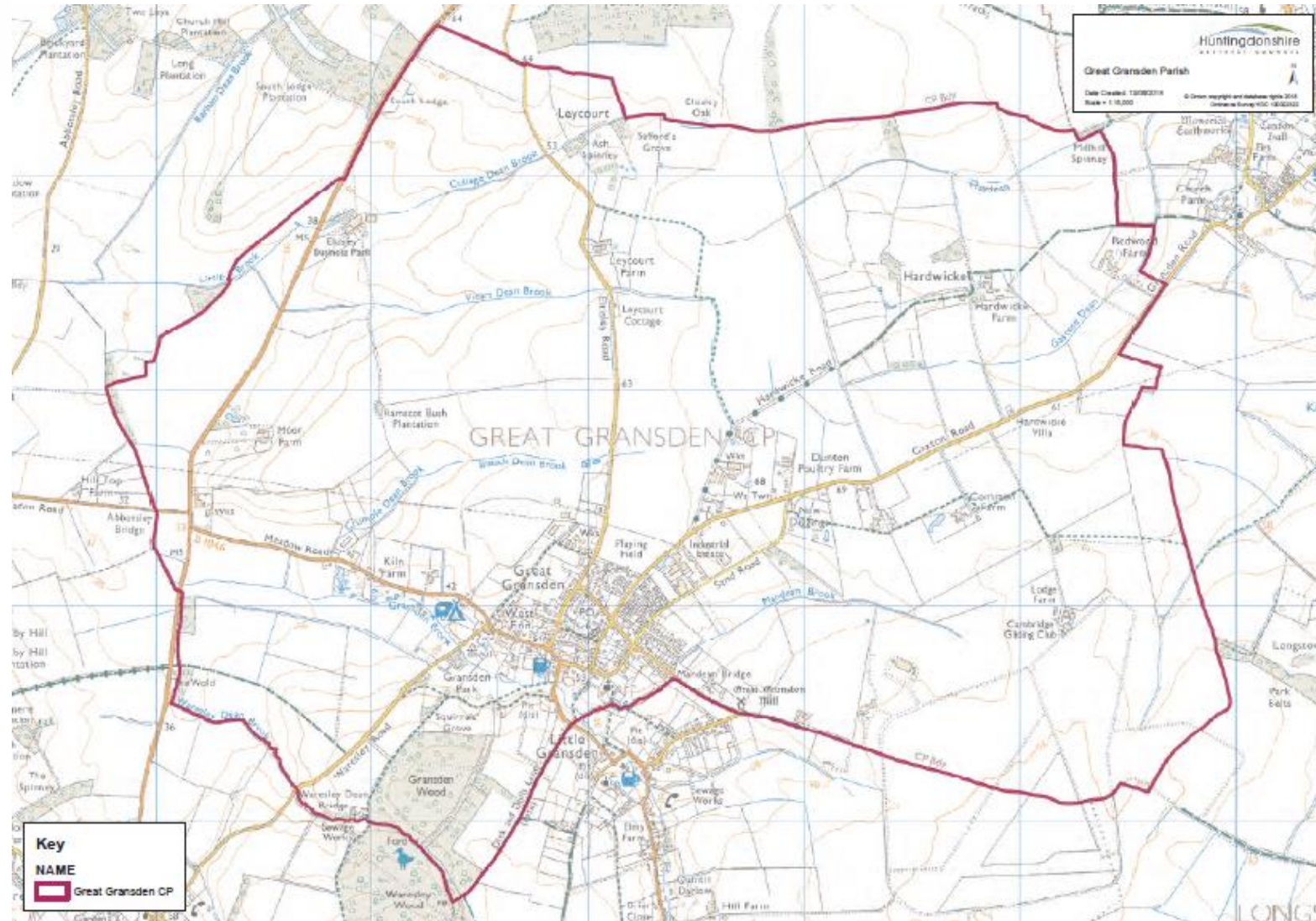
What is a Neighbourhood Development Plan?

- Our opportunity to have our say in the future sustainable development and conservation of Great Gransden
- Includes the use and development of land and infrastructure relating to housing, employment, heritage, natural environment and transport.
- When approved, the Plan must be considered for all future planning decisions.
- It will be written to represent the consensus of views of the Great Gransden community, covering the entire Parish.

- ***How will this be achieved?***
- Great Gransden Parish Council (GGPC) is sponsoring the preparation of the Plan.
- The activity is being led by a Steering Group of Great Gransden residents
- Everyone in the village is welcome and encouraged to be involved in the Plan. The Steering Group will aim to reach all sections of our community to seek their views about what should be included in the Plan.
- The Plan must be consistent with the strategic policies in the Huntingdonshire District local area development plan and comply with European and national policies

What does a Neighbourhood Development Plan contain?

Evidence base:

- A factual overview of the parish, including heritage, housing, education, environment, facilities & amenities, population demographics, businesses....
- Issues and challenges for the parish
- Opinions gathered from Great Gransden residents and other interested parties, including the school, local businesses, societies, adjacent parishes.....

Proposals

- Planning policies to guide future development of the parish up to 2036
- Community actions, to complement the planning policies



The Story so far.....What have we achieved?

- Approval of plan area by Hunts District Council
- Housing Needs Survey completed
- All households and businesses surveyed with initial questionnaire
- Stalls at Community events
- Engagement with Barnabas Oley, Nursery and Playgroup
- Identified the major likes and concerns about the village, and the places that are most valued
- Grant funding awarded to complete the first phase of the plan

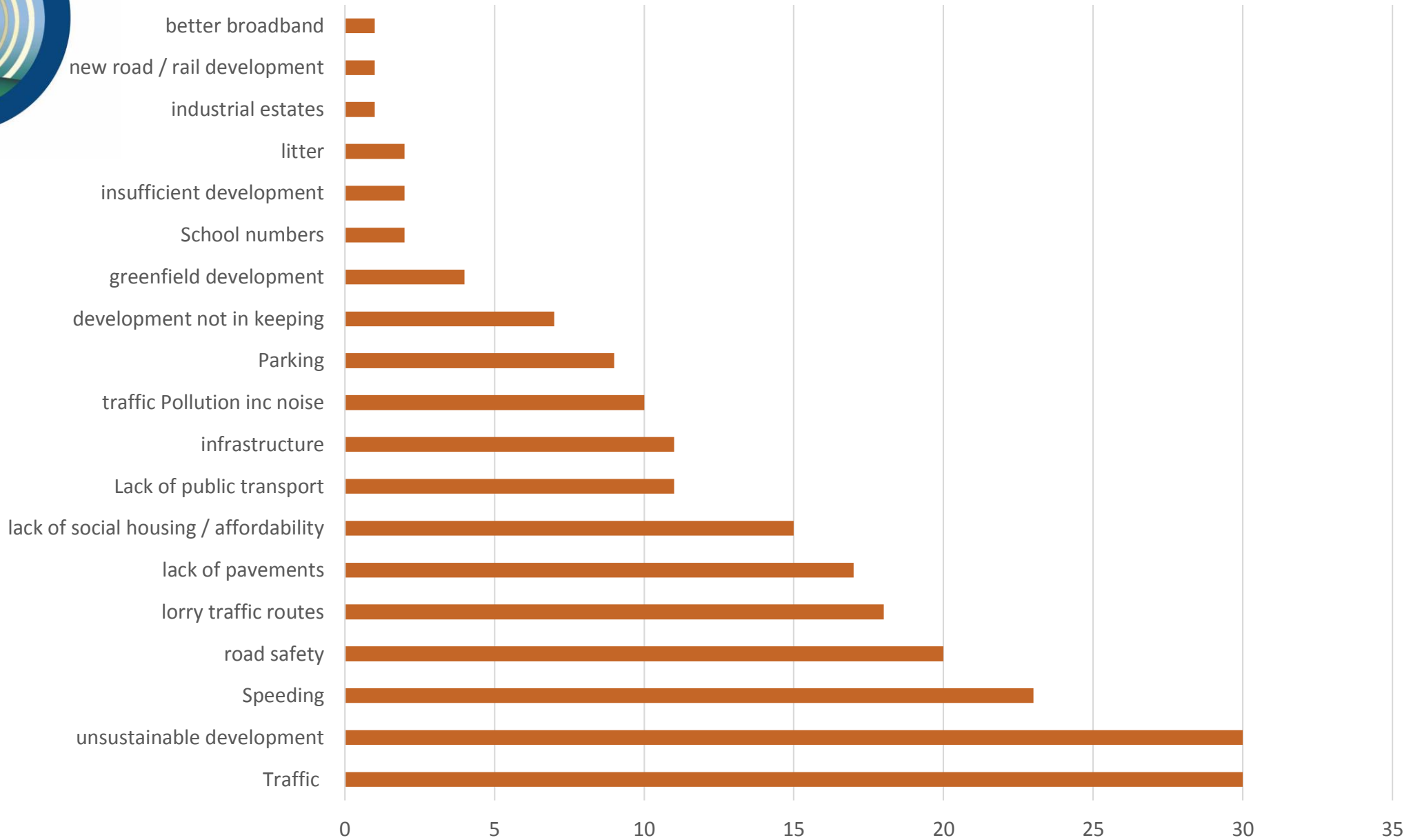


What next? And how can you help?

- Vote in the referendum

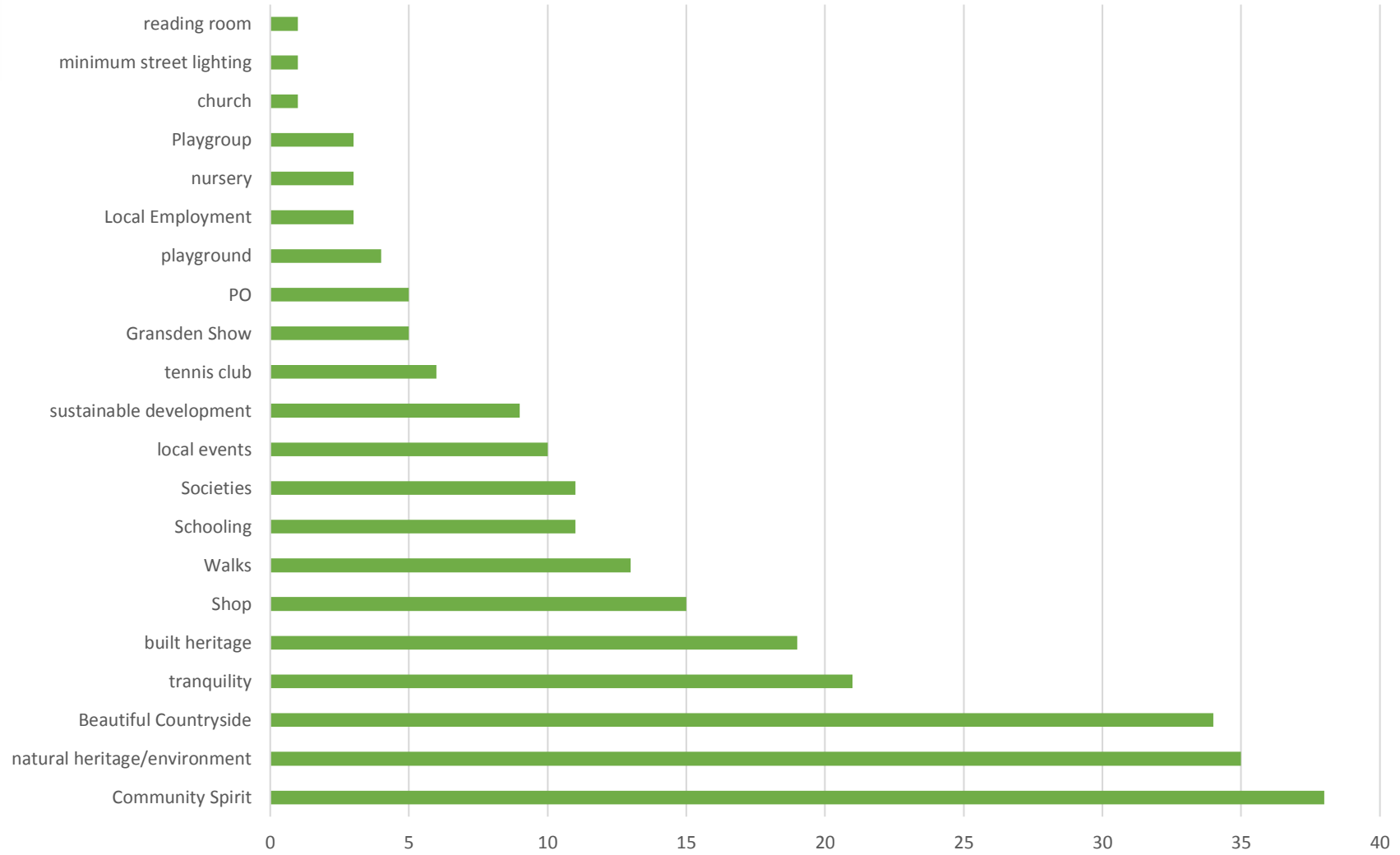


Dislikes / Concerns Adult Responses



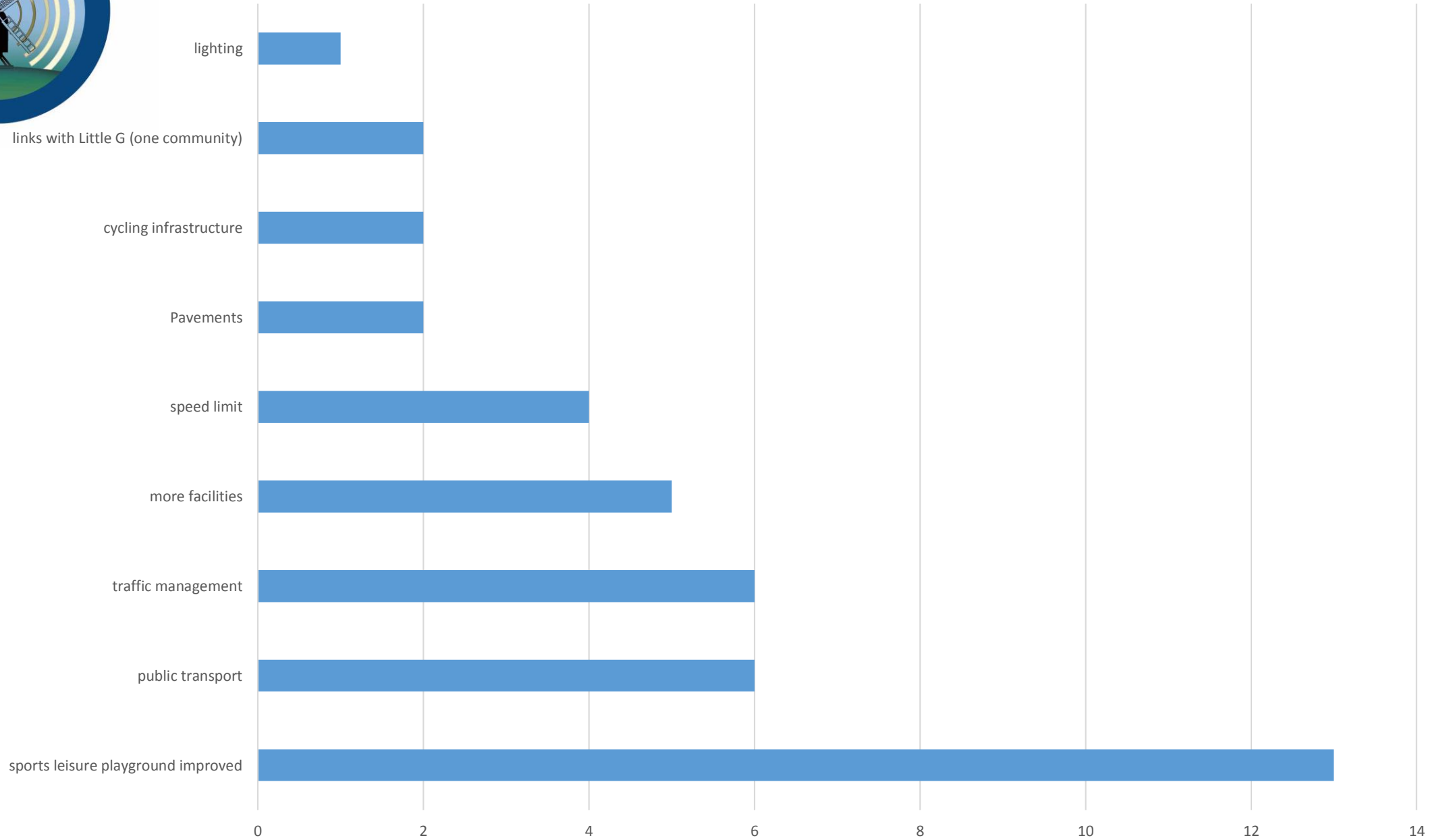


Likes - Adult Responses



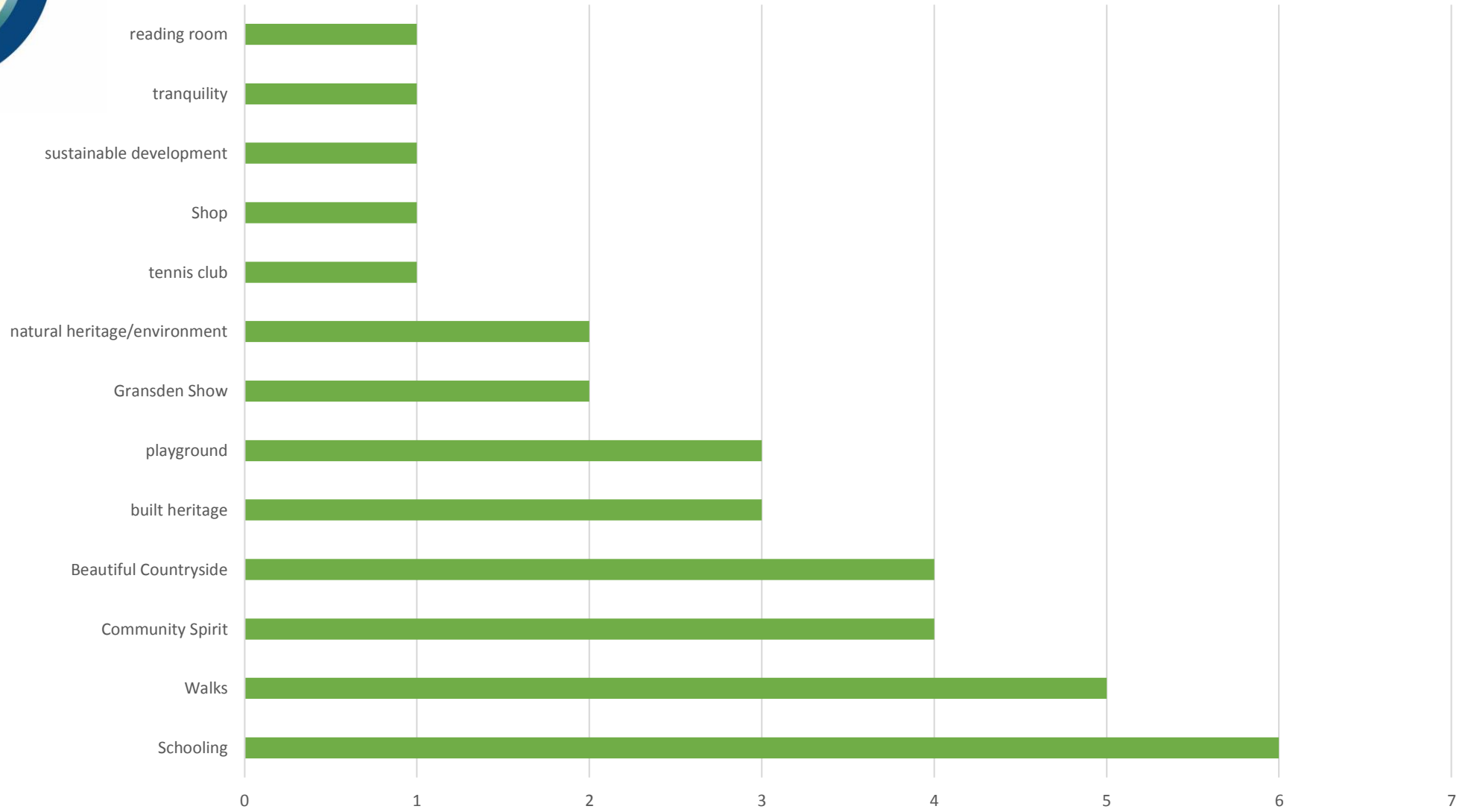


Changes – Adult Responses
